## 1. Storing photos in folders on computer and finding file size

Golden Rule – make a copy before editing – always keep the original. Click on properties to find file size and details

# Using Paint.net – free image editing software – Basics

**Paint.NET is not available for Mac** but there are plenty of alternatives that runs on macOS with similar functionality. The best Mac alternative is GIMP, which is both free and Open Source.

“Paint.NET is a lightweight yet capable program that’s easy to navigate and is regularly updated.

You’ll quickly become acquainted with this powerful, yet easy-to-learn program’s features; tools, layers, adjustments, and effects. See how to correct exposure, digitally retouch and repair damaged photos, and handle a broad spectrum of photo editing tasks—even how to colorize a black-and-white image. You’ll also learn how to create digital art using the Paint.NET drawing tools and effects. Practice files are provided with step-by-step instructions to jump into photo editing and art creation.”

## 1. Download

## 2. Cropping images

**Demo – open image – rectangular select – can use move selection tool – image – crop to selection - save as**

### 3. Cropping to a specific ratio or size

#### Boots prints:

6 x 4 inches = 10 x 15cm

6.7 x 4.5 inches = 11 x 17cm

7 x 5 inches = 13 x 18cm

5 x 3.5 inches = 10 x 15cm

8 x 6 inches

10 x 8 inches

12 x 8 inches

#### Additional BonusPrint sizes

4 x 4 inches

5 x 5 inches

6.5 x 5 inches

4.8 x 4 inches

7.5 x 5 inches

#### Demo:

1. Open an image in Paint.Net.
2. Click the rectangle Select in Tools. ...
3. Change normal to fixed ratio.
4. Adjust the width and height and drag on your image.
5. Image - Crop to Selection. ...
6. File – Save As
7. Give it a new file name and choose where to save it
8. Decide on quality-file size – and Press OK
