> The Next Open Meeting Monday 21st October 2024 Chris Truran presents his talk: "Dabs and DNA Detects Criminals"



The development of fingerprints at the beginning of the 20th century up to the first crime solved using DNA. Chris covers the first criminals convicted by fingerprints, the Brighton Bombing, Lockerbie, the Tsunami, James Hanratty - and a daughter's DNA that solved a 30 year old murder by her father.

Chris joined the Metropolitan Police in 1975 and trained as a Scenes of Crimes Officer (SOCO). He worked in London and examined over 25,000 crime scenes ranging from shop-lifting to murder, starting 38 years ago when DNA was in its embryonic stage.
